SCOOPLET ... MELTZ LAUNCHES CRISIS MANAGEMENT FIRM: Gary Meltz, former senior vice president at **Dezenhall Resources**, is launching a boutique crisis management and public affairs firm called MELTZ Communication. 
FRAISER JOINS THE INGRAM GROUP: Beecher Frasier will be joining the the Ingram Group and the First Group as a principal. Fraiser is a former Democratic chief of staff and excampaign manager of former Rep. Harold Ford Jr.'s 2006 Senate race. "We're very excited to have Beecher join our team. He knows and navigates Tennessee and Washington with an engaging personality and tremendous knowledge, experience and skill," said Tom Ingram, founder and chairman of the Nashville-Washington consulting business ... "He obviously brings U. S House experience and strength to our team, but is also a very broad-gauged professional."

Fraiser comes to the firm from **Paramount Strategies**, where he was working as a contract lobbyist. He'll continue to live in Tennessee and be based in The Ingram Group's Nashville office and commute on a regular basis to The First Group office. The First Group recently lost partners Kyle Simmons and Bob Russell, who left on amicable terms to form their own firm, the Simmons & Russell Group.

 ${\bf Ingram\ and\ Fraiser-now\ partners-have\ squared\ off\ politically\ when\ {\bf Bob\ Corker}\ and\ Ford\ ran}$ against each other for an open U.S. Senate seat. Ingram left his post as Lamar Alexander's chief of staff to manage the flagging Corker campaign in the last stretch. Corker edged Ford on election day. Frasier and Ingram, both alumni of Lipscomb University in Nashville and long-time friends before the Corker-Ford race, overnight became fierce adversaries during that race. "We pledged to each other to be friends when it was over and to call each other's hand in the meantime if things got out of hand," Ingram said. "We called each other several times."

THE POLITICS OF FOOTBALL: Professional football season wraps up this Sunday with the Super Bowl, but for the league and players' union, many off-the-field battles will rage on. PI's rounded up some numbers on the industry's lobbying in the past year, which bridges issues from drug testing to player safety to broadcast and intellectual property issues. The National Football League spent just over \$1 million in 2013, on par with what it spent in 2012, but down some previous years when it first registered in 2009. It retains a string of heavy hitters on K Street, including: Covington & Burling, Elmendorf Ryan, Fierce, Isakowitz & Blalock, Gephardt Group Government Affairs, Patton Boggs and The Glover Park Group. Patton Boggs had represented the **NFL Players' Union** for a number of years, but the contract was terminated Dec. 31. The players' union added the Fierce, Isakowitz & Blalock back in October to work on antitrust, telecommunications and labor issues. Spending with Patton Boggs had tapered off from \$100,000-plus per quarter in 2010 to just \$30,000 per quarter, which is also what it paid Fierce, Isakowitz & Blalock in Q4.

CFA OPENS EUROPEAN OFFICE: The Commercial Finance Association announced Thursday that it is opening a new European chapter to support asset based lenders doing business on the continent. "Cross-border asset-based lending is growing and the new European chapter will help CFA members cultivate the industry contacts necessary to make these deals happen, particularly in the syndicated ABL space," said Bob Trojan, Chief Executive Officer of the CFA. "Our members indicated a need for an organization to facilitate European ABL deals and strongly supported the creation of the CFA European Chapter." The London-based chapter will have an all-European focus, according to a release.

RAMOS TAKES OVER VA LIAISON OFFICE: Maribel Ramos has been named the new director of the McAuliffe administration's Virginia Liaison Office in Washington, D.C. She will function as the head of Congressional and Federal Affairs for the Governor and the Cabinet. Ramos served previously as Legislative Assistant to Sen. **Tim Kaine**, where she advised the senator on policy areas including education, economic development, housing, immigration and appropriations. Prior to that she served as a legislative assistant to Sen. Jim Webb, policy assistant to then-Gov. Tim Kaine and Latino liaison and special assistant to then-Gov. Mark Warner.
